
Blackboard Ultra Updates



NEW FEATURE ALERT! – AI Conversation Role Play


A new feature is now available in Bb Ultra courses. There is now another option under the AI Conversation assignment – Role Play.



This assignment is created like other assignment types. Click one of the little plus signs and then Create:




And then scroll down and click on AI Conversation:



You can define the scenario for the student and then create the AI persona. It is like all other assignments where you will need to set due dates, visibility, grading...etc. This can be a fun engaging assignment for your students.

Vote and Comment - Other community members can upvote ideas they find valuable, and comments allow for additional feedback or refinements to the suggestion. The popularity of an idea helps signal its importance to Blackboard's development team.

Feedback from Blackboard - Blackboard's team reviews top-voted ideas and provides periodic updates on whether the suggestions are under review, planned for development, or completed. This transparency helps users stay informed about which ideas are being prioritized.
